

Glenmorangie / Golf Chicago Magazine "Tournament of Champions"

OFFICIAL RULES

1. No purchase necessary to enter or claim prize. The Glenmorangie / Golf Chicago Magazine Tournament of Champions (the "Tournament") is a golf tournament organized and conducted by Golf Chicago Magazine ("Organizer") and sponsored by Moët Hennessy USA, Inc. on behalf of its Glenmorangie single malt scotch brand ("Sponsor"). The Tournament is open to legal U.S. residents who are at least 21 years of age or older and are currently members in one of the Participating Chicago-area Golf Clubs listed below, and who have been certified by their club pro at participating clubs as the top flight club champion for 2008. The following persons are not eligible to enter: employees of Organizer, Sponsor, and their respective affiliates, partners, subsidiaries, distributors, advertising and promotion agencies, alcohol beverage retail licensees and the immediate families or household members of each. The Tournament is subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations. Void where prohibited or restricted by law or regulations.

2. How to enter and participate: Only eligible club champions at the participating golf clubs listed below who have been certified by their club pro as the top flight club champion for 2008 may participate in the Tournament. The head club professional at each participating club shall furnish to Organizer its champion's name and contact information within 72 hours of completion of its club championship and in sufficient time for the champion to participate in the Tournament.

3. The Tournament. The Tournament will be held on September 8, 2008 at Hawthorn Woods Country Club in Hawthorn Woods, Illinois. The Tournament will be 18 holes of medal (stroke) play. The course set up (tee and pin positions, rough length, etc.) shall be determined at the discretion of the greens staff of the host club, Hawthorn Woods. In the event of a tie, the winner shall be determined by sudden death playoff. Standard USGA rules apply. Marshals will be provided by Golf Chicago Magazine. In the event of inclement weather and at the discretion of the Sponsor, the rain date for the Tournament is September 15, 2008.

4. Prizes / Approximate Retail Value ("ARV"): The Tournament Winner shall receive a trip for himself or herself and three (3) guests to Scotland to visit the Glenmorangie distillery in Tain, Ross-Shire, Scotland, and no less than three (3) rounds of Scottish golf (the "Tournament Winner's Prize"). Actual courses played will be subject to availability at the time of travel. Sponsor shall use reasonable efforts to arrange play at Scottish courses that are in the British Open rotation and/or are well renowned. Travel must occur before September 8, 2009. The Tournament Winner must provide at least 60-90 days notice of proposed travel dates. Sponsor shall make efforts to accommodate the Tournament Winner's desired travel dates, but timing of Tournament Prize will be subject to availability. Tournament Prize shall include round trip coach airfare for the winner and three guests, double occupancy lodging / accommodations, all greens fees and meals at the Glenmorangie distillery. All other meals and entertainment are Tournament Winner's responsibility. ARV of the Tournament Winner's Prize: \$9300. Tournament Winner will be required to sign and return to Sponsor an affidavit of eligibility and liability/publicity release within seven (7) days of the date of winning notification; otherwise prize will be forfeited, and a new winner -- as determined by the official scores of the Tournament - will be selected. Tournament Winner's travel companions must be at least 21 years of age and each will be required to sign a Liability/Publicity Release (where legal) prior to ticketing. The Tournament Winner will receive (i) recognition in Golf Chicago magazine. Prize does not include meals unless as specified above, additional room taxes, insurance, telephone charges, personal expenses, ground transportation, gratuities, passenger facility charges (PFCs), security charges, departure taxes, or any incidentals or other expenses not specifically described in these Official Rules, for which Tournament Winner is solely responsible. ARV may vary depending upon departure points and airfare fluctuations. Restrictions on hotel and flight availability may apply. Tournament Winner and travel companions are responsible for all required travel documentation. All federal, state, local and other taxes, costs and expenses relating to the use, acceptance and possession of the prizes are the sole responsibility of the Tournament Winner. Prize is non-

transferable and no substitution by winner or cash equivalent is allowed. Sponsor reserves the right to substitute prizes for one of equal or greater value.

5. Release of Liability: By participating, you release Sponsor, Organizer and their respective subsidiaries, affiliates, partners, employees, directors, agents, advertising agencies, and all others associated with the development and execution of the Tournament, from any and against any and all injury, loss or damage caused or claimed to be caused by your participation in the Tournament and/or the acceptance, awarding, receipt, use and/or misuse of the prize, and you agree that these entities are in no matter responsible for any warranty, representation, or guarantee, expressed or implied, in fact or in law, relating to the promotion and/or the awarding of the prizes. Notwithstanding the foregoing, if the Tournament and/or the prize described in the preceding release is determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or void for any reason, entrants agree that, by entering the Tournament, (i) any and all disputes, claims, and causes of action arising out of or in connection with the Tournament, or any prizes awarded, shall be resolved individually without resort to any form of class action; (ii) any claims, judgments and awards shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs incurred, including costs associated with entering the Contest, but in no event attorney's fees; and (iii) under no circumstances will any entrant be permitted to obtain any award for, and entrant hereby waives all rights to claim, punitive, incidental or consequential damages and any and all rights to have damages multiplied or otherwise increased and any other damages, other than damages for actual out-of-pocket expenses.

6. Additional Rules: Entrants agree to these Official Rules and the decisions of the Tournament judges and the Sponsor and Organizer, and on their behalf, and on behalf of their respective heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, successors and assigns ("Releasing Parties"), release, defend and hold harmless the Sponsor, the Organizer, as well as the employees, officers, directors and agents of each ("Released Parties"), from any and all actions, causes of action, suits, debts, dues, sums of money, accounts, reckonings, bonds, bills, specialties, covenants, contracts, controversies, agreements, promises, variances, trespasses, lost profits, indirect or direct damages, consequential damages, incidental damages, punitive or exemplary damages, judgments, extent, executions, claims and demands whatsoever, in law, admiralty or equity, whether known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen, against Released Parties which any one or more of the Releasing Parties ever had, now have or hereafter can, shall or may have which in any way arise out of or result from entrant's participation, acceptance and use or misuse of any prize, including any travel related activities. Sponsor or Organizer is not responsible for any typographical or other error in the printing of the Tournament rules and materials, administration of the Tournament or in the announcement of any prize. In the event Sponsor or Organizer is prevented from conducting the Tournament or awarding the prize as contemplated herein by any event beyond its control, including but not limited to fire, flood, earthquake, explosion, labor dispute or strike, act of God or public enemy, satellite or equipment failure, riot or civil disturbance, terrorist threat or activity, war (declared or undeclared) or any federal, state, or local government law, order, or regulation, or order of any court or other cause not within Sponsor or Organizer's control, each shall have the right to modify, suspend, extend or terminate the Tournament or the travel to Scotland by Tournament Winner. Tournament participants assume all liability for any injury, including death or damage caused or claimed to be caused, by participation in the Tournament or use or redemption of any prize. By participating in the Tournament, entrants (i) agree to be bound by these Official Rules, including all eligibility requirements, and (ii) agree to be bound by the decisions of Sponsor, the Organizer and the Tournament judges, which are final and binding in all matters relating to the Tournament. Failure to comply with these Official Rules may result in disqualification from the Tournament and ineligibility for the prizes.

Sponsor reserves the right to: (i) permanently disqualify from the Tournament any entrant if Sponsor believes that such person has intentionally violated these Official Rules; and (ii) suspend, modify or terminate the Tournament if Sponsor believes, in its sole discretion, that malfunction, error, disruption or damage is impairing or will impair the administration, security, fairness, integrity of the Tournament. Sponsor and Organizer reserve the right to disqualify any unauthorized entries, including, without limitation, multiple entries from the same person.
