A descendant of a long line of distillers dating as far back as 1782, Jack Teeling opened a small craft distillery in Dublin's Liberties district, once the epicenter of Irish whiskey, just seven years ago.

Teeling Single Pot Still Irish Whiskey is crafted using a recipe of 50% unmalted spring barley and 50% malted barley, matured in a combination of virgin oak, ex-wine and ex-bourbon barrels.

Teeling Single Grain Irish Whiskey is one of only a handful of single grain bottlings in the world. It is matured in red wine barrels, resulting in an intensely fruity amber liquid with lush berry notes.

Teeling Single Malt Irish Whiskey is made from 100% malted barley and has a taste that combines dry fruits with citrus, vanilla, spice and cloves.
